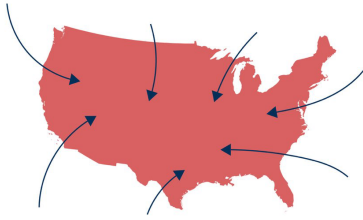

Join us for a discussion about what every practitioner should know regarding the convergence of immigration and criminal law, including important updates.



John Anthony Balli is an Immigration Attorney with the Office of The Webb County Public Defender. As an in house Immigration

Attorney, Mr. Balli works with non-citizen defendants and their appointed attorney to advise of immigration consequences related to a charged crime and assists counsel by suggesting alternative plea agreements to avert negative immigration consequences. He has a B.A. from St. Edward's University, a B.S. from Texas A&M International University, and a J.D. from St. Mary's University School of Law.



Jodi Goodwin practices immigration law in the trenches on the border in Harlingen, Texas. Since 1995 she has represented thou-

sands of asylum seekers, economic migrants, long-term permanent residents, businesses, families, and United States citizens in immigration and nationality matters. She also represents immigrants and United States citizens in federal court in both criminal and civil proceedings. Ms. Goodwin attended the University of Texas and St. Mary's University.



Jordan Pollock has been the Immigration Specialist at the Dallas County Public Defender's Office since 2014. Ms. Pollock is also

an adjunct professor teaching "crimmigration" at Texas A&M Law School. Previously, Ms. Pollock was an Equal Justice Works Fellow/ Staff Attorney at Public Counsel in Los Angeles and represented detained immigrants in removal proceedings. She received her J.D. with honors from the University of Texas School of Law and a B.A. from Duke University.
